When Durood Sharif is recited in this manner, it transcends mere habit and tradition, and without a doubt, its wondrous lights will be manifested."

THE BLESSINGS OF JALSA SALANA UK: A REFLECTION OF THE TRUE ISLAM

His Holiness Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) discussed the success of Jalsa Salana UK, which concluded the prior week. He initially mentioned how the volunteers, be they men, women, or children, all performed 'silent *tabligh*' by working diligently many days before, as well as after the Jalsa. Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) stated how many Khuddam and volunteers had come from Canada and Mauritius this year.

Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) then described the positive impressions of guests of the Jalsa, who were visiting from all across the globe. He mentioned the comments of a chief Buddhist priest in Japan, a doctor from Taiwan, another doctor from Tanzania, a government worker from Chile, as well as guests from many other countries. For instance, Yasin Ahmadi, a guest from Canada, said: "I have found the Jalsa Salana of the Ahmadiyya Jama'at to be an event based on faith and full of wisdom and knowledge. Ahmadis' character, sense of respect for each other, patience, and a moderate interpretation of Islamic teachings are all vitalizing and inspirational after centuries of religious bloodshed and violence."

At the end, Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) said, "While this Jalsa has been instrumental in providing spiritual training to the Ahmadis, it has also helped people of other faiths in knowing about Islamic teachings and coming closer to Allah. Hence, we should bow before Allah more than before and express our gratitude to Him." August 9, 2024 BATTLE OF MURAYSI

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) continued his series of sermons on the expeditions during the life of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him). He highlighted an incident where a servant of Hazrat Umar (may Allah be pleased with him), named Jahjah, and a member of a tribe allied with the Ansar, named Sinan, quarreled over a trivial matter. Being uncultured and illiterate, they nearly sparked a conflict between the Muhajirin and Ansar. The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) intervened, emphasizing peace. But Abdullah bin Ubai, chief of the hypocrites, tried to exploit the situation, and even declared, "When we reach Madinah, the most honourable one [referring to himself], would expel the least honourable one [referring to the Holy Prophet^{sa}]." However, the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) displayed remarkable forbearance.

The sermon also touched on the vandalism against Ahmadi Muslims in Bangladesh during political unrest, with mosques and properties damaged. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) urged prayers for Ahmadis facing persecution, and for the Muslim world, including Palestinians, to find peace and justice. He concluded by mentioning two deceased Ahmadis, Dr. Zakaur Rahman Sahib, known for his selfless service, and Saida Bashir Sahiba, a devoted and pious woman, and he led their funeral prayers in absentia.

August 16, 2024 EXPEDITION OF BANU MUSTALIQ

In this sermon, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) discussed the aftermath of the Battle of Banu Mustaliq. He recounted the Holy Prophet's^{sa} initiatives, such as establishing grazing grounds for war animals at Naqi' and organizing sports to uplift his Companions'^{ra} spirits. The Holy Prophet's^{sa} lighthearted race with Hazrat Aisha (may Allah be pleased with her) exemplified his loving and respectful treatment of his wives.

Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) also elaborated on the Incident of *Ifk* [the Great Calumny], where hypocrites falsely accused Hazrat Aisha (may Allah be pleased with her) of adultery. She was unwittingly left behind on a journey and later found by Hazrat Safwan bin Mu'attal (may Allah be pleased with him), who returned her to the Muslim camp. Despite this innocence, rumours spread, causing her great distress. Eventually, Allah revealed her innocence to the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him). Hazrat Abu Bakr (may Allah be pleased with him), Hazrat Aisha's^{ra} father, initially resolved to stop aiding Mistah^{ra}, one of the accusers, but later continued his support following Divine guidance.

Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) concluded by asking for prayers for Ahmadis facing persecution in Bangladesh and Pakistan, as well as for Palestinians and the entire Muslim Ummah at large.

August 23, 2024 JALSA SALANA GERMANY 2024

In this Friday Sermon, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) said that Jalsa Salana Germany is commencing today. The German Jama'at was expecting my presence at the Jalsa, but human limitations of health are a part of life. Due to these factors and the advice of doctors, I have decided to postpone my trip and address the Jalsa attendees through a live telecast.

He also stated that instead of holding the Jalsa in pre-built halls, it has been arranged in an open space. Due to this, the administration will need to work harder to prepare the site, and both the guests and the administration may face some challenges. However, meeting these challenges and fulfilling the purpose of attending the Jalsa should be the goal for both the attendees and the administration.

Every Ahmadi attending the Jalsa should keep in mind that if there is no effort to increase in love for Allah, to practice high morals, to fulfil the rights of others, and to strive for piety, then the purpose of attending the Jalsa is not being fulfilled.

Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) made a special appeal for daily supplications based on a vision of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih III (may Allah have mercy upon him). This spiritual regimen has been published and circulated throughout the worldwide Jama'at, as well as in the previous issue of the Gazette.

August 30, 2024 THE INCIDENT OF THE GREAT CALUMNY


Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) mentioned details of the incident of the Great Calumny [ifk] against Hazrat Aisha (may Allah be pleased with her). Huzoor-e-Anwar (may Allah be his Helper) quoted from the passages of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) and Hazrat Mirza Bashir Ahmad (may Allah be pleased with him).

In his book *Sirat Khatamun Nabiyyin*, Hazrat Mirza Bashir Ahmad (may Allah be pleased with him) detailed the incident, in reference to Sahih Bukhari, underscoring its gravity as an attack on the Holy Prophet's^{sa} dignity and Hazrat Aisha's^{ra} character. These accusations are baseless fabrications by so-called scholars, who have been making these allegations since the inception of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community. He also quoted the famous Persian couplet of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him):

Sending Blessings on the Holy Prophet^{sa}

EDITOR'S NOTE: The following is an English translation of excerpts from the Friday Sermon of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) which he delivered on February 24, 2006 at the Baitul Futuh Mosque in London. The Ahmadiyya Gazette Canada's editorial team accepts full responsibility for any errors in translation.



Today, every Ahmadi needs to pay great attention to prayers because the Muslim world is in an extremely dire situation due to its own mistakes. If we have true love and affection for the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), we should also pray fervently for the Ummah. We need to focus on this, just as we have been doing before. But today, I want to draw attention to how we should pray. The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) himself taught us the ways and manners of praying, through which we not only reform ourselves but also witness the acceptance of our prayers.

THE PROPHET'S MOSQUE, MADINAH

In a Hadith, it is narrated that Hazrat Umar bin Khattab (may Allah be pleased with him) said:

"The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said that a prayer remains suspended between the heavens and the earth, and none of it ascends (to be presented before Allah) until you send blessings (Durood) upon your Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him)."

[*Tirmidhi*, no. 486]

This is a truth that Allah the Almighty has also clearly stated to us in the Holy Qur'an, in the verse I have just recited:

رِنَّ اللَّهَ وَمَلَّئِكَتَهُ يُصَلُّوْنَ عَلَى النَّبِيِّ آيَّةًا الَّذِيْنَ أَمَنُوْا صَلُّوْا عَلَيْهِ وَسَلِّمُوْا تَسْلِيْمًا @

"Allah and His angels send blessings on the Prophet. O ye who believe! you also should invoke blessings on him and salute him with the salutation of peace." (33:57)

The Holy Qur'an contains numerous commandments that instruct us on what to do, and by acting upon them, the result is that you become beloved to Allah, you inherit His blessings, you draw closer to Him, you are saved from Hell, and you enter Paradise. Here, there is a task that is so significant and great that Allah has even assigned His angels to it, and Allah Himself sends blessings and peace upon His beloved Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him).

Therefore, this is an act that, by doing it, you are following the example or act that Allah Himself performs. When Allah grants us such great rewards for following His commandments, then how immense will be the reward for performing this act that Allah Himself does? And surely, the *Durood* [blessing] that is sent with sincerity will lead to the reformation of the Ummah. It will protect the Ummah from disgrace, bring about our own reformation, and serve as a means for the acceptance of our prayers. It will also be a means to safeguard us from the trials of the *Dajjal* (the Antichrist).

The benefits of sending Durood upon the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) are mentioned in various Ahadith. In one narration, the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said that on the Day of Judgment, the closest person to me will be the one who sent the most Durood upon me. [*Tirmidhi*, no. 484]

The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) further said:

"Whoever sends Durood upon me once with sincere devotion, Allah will send blessings upon him ten times, elevate him by ten ranks, record ten good deeds for him, and forgive ten of his sins."

[Kanzul Ummal, Hadith no. 2220] ...

While sending Durood, each person should reflect upon their inner self and their heart, examining how much worldliness is mixed in and how much attention is being given to sending Durood with true sincerity. How purely are we sending Durood?



THE BLESSED TOMB OF THE HOLY PROPHET^{SA}

The Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) says regarding this:

"Recite Durood Sharif abundantly, as it is a powerful means to attain steadfastness, but do not do so out of mere habit or custom. Instead, keep in mind the beauty and favours of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), and recite it for the elevation of his ranks and for his successes. The result will be that you will enjoy the sweet and delightful fruits of the acceptance of your prayers."

[Malfuzat (2022), vol. 4, p. 151]

So, these are the proper ways of sending Durood.

The Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) further said:

"O people! Send Durood upon this Benefactor Prophet who is the manifestation of the attributes of the Gracious and Merciful Lord, for indeed, the recompense for a favour is nothing but a favour. And a heart that does not perceive his favours either lacks faith entirely or is bent on destroying it. O Allah! Send Durood upon that unlettered Messenger and Prophet who has quenched the thirst of the later generations just as he quenched the thirst of the earlier ones and imbued them with his colour, and included them among the pure ones."

[*Ijaz-ul-Masih*, Ruhani Khaza'in, vol. 18, pp. 5-6]

When Durood is thus sent with true sincerity and collectively, then such Durood manifests its effects. Those who claim that Durood does not have an impact should understand from this Hadith and the teachings of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) that this is not the case. One should never tire of sending Durood; rather, they should self-reflect. The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) has said, "The one who does not send Durood upon me is a miser" [Tirmidhi, Hadith no. 3546). Not only do such people commit the sin of miserliness, but they are also deprived of Allah's grace. As we have already seen, Allah sends ten blessings upon a person who sends Durood once. To receive Allah's blessings in this way is such a great deal that even the companions of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) and some companions of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) would at times abandon all other supplications and only recite Durood.

The Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), while advising someone in a letter, said:


"Engage in the Tahajjud Salat and other regular supplications. There are many blessings in Tahajjud. Idleness is nothing; one who is idle and lazy holds no weight. Allah the Almighty has said,

وَالَّذِيْنَ جَاهَدُوْا فِيْنَا لَنَهْدِيَنَّهُمْ سُبُلَنَا

[And those who strive in Our path—We will surely guide them in Our ways. (29:70)]

The best Durood is the one that came from the blessed tongue of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), and that is:

اَللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَى آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ كَمَا صَلَّيْتَ عَلَى إِبْرَاهِيمَ وَعَلَى آلِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ إِنَّكَ حَمِيدٌ مَجِيدٌ . اَللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَى آل مُحَمَّدٍ كَمَا بَارَكْتَ عَلَى إِبْرَاهِيمَ وَعَلَى آلِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ إِنَّكَ حَمِيدٌ مَجِيدٌ . ['O Allah, bless Muhammad and the people of Muhammad as You blessed Abraham and the people of Abraham; You are indeed Praiseworthy and Glorious. O Allah, send Your blessings upon Muhammad and the people of Muhammad as You blessed Abraham and the people of Abraham; You are indeed Praiseworthy and Glorious.']"

He further stated:

"The words that come from the mouth of a righteous person surely contain blessings. So imagine how blessed the words must be that came from the mouth of the leader of the righteous and the commander of the prophets. Thus, of all the forms of Durood, this is the most blessed. This is the Durood I personally recite, and there is no restriction on the number of times it should be recited. It should be recited with sincerity, love, presence of heart, and humility until a state of deep emotion, spiritual ecstasy, and effect is achieved, and one feels expansion and joy in the chest."

[Maktubat-e-Ahmad [2008], vol. 1, p. 526]

... This is the era of the latter days-the time linked to the triumphs of Islam. These triumphs, as we all know, were not achieved through swords, guns, or cannons, but through the power of prayers. The weapon of reasoning and proofs, given to the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him). It is through these means that Islam will prevail, Insha'Allah. For the acceptance of prayers and to attain Allah's nearness and blessings, Allah the Almighty has made it clear to us—we have already seen from various Ahadith and the Qur'anic verse—that sending Durood upon the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) is essential. The Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) has also taught us that the high spiritual status he was granted was due to his sending Durood upon the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him). This is also connected to the future victories of Islam.

Regarding the status that Allah granted him by sending him to the world as the Messiah and Mahdi, the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) mentioned a revelation and stated:

"The revelation after this is as follows:

صَلٍّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَأَلِ مُحَمَّدٍ سَيِّدِ وُلْدِ أَدَمَ وَخَاتَمَ النَّبِيِّيْنَ

Call down blessings on Muhammad and the progeny of Muhammad, who is the Chief of the children of Adam and is the Seal of the Prophets, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him.

"This indicates that all these ranks, munificence, and favours are on account of him, and a reward for loving him. Holy is Allah! What high ranks the Chief of all creation has in the presence of the One True God and what kind of nearness does he have to Him that his lover becomes the beloved of God, and his servant is appointed the master of a whole world! ...

"At this time, I recall that one night this humble one recited Durood Sharif so abundantly that my heart and soul became fragrant therewith. The same night I saw in a dream that people were carrying into the house of this humble one waterskins filled with divine light in the form of pure water and one of them said, 'These are the very blessings which you had sent to Muhammad, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him.'

"I recall a similar wonderful experience. Once I re-

ceived a revelation which indicated that there was a vigorous discussion in the High Assembly in Heaven. That is, God's will for the revival of the Faith was surging, but the appointment of the man to revive the Faith was not yet disclosed to the High Assembly, and this is why they were in disagreement. It was at this time in the dream that I saw people searching for a revivor.

"A man appeared before my humble self and, pointing towards me, he said:

"Meaning that, this is the man who loves the Messenger of Allah.

"The meaning of this statement was that the principal qualification for this mission is the love of the Holy Prophet^{sa} and that this quality was definitely found in me. Similarly, the secret behind the direction to call down blessings on the Holy Prophet's progeny in the revelation mentioned above is that the love for the members of the household of the Holy Prophet^{sa} plays a great part in acquiring divine light. Anyone who is included among those who have attained nearness to the One True God attains the spiritual inheritance of those righteous and holy ones, and becomes their heir in respect of knowledge and divine insights.

[Barahin-e-Ahmadiyya — Part IV (English, 2016), pp. 378-379]

Thus, it is the responsibility of every Ahmadi today—a tremendous responsibility—to recite Durood abundantly, to pray for themselves and for the rest of the Muslims, so that Allah may save the Muslim Ummah from destruction.

The love for the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) demands that we make ample space for the Muslim Ummah in our prayers. The intentions of others are not right. We do not know what further trials, tribulations, and difficulties these people will face, nor what plans are being devised against them. May Allah have mercy on them.

May Allah always guide us on the right path, make us grateful servants, and grant us the ability to fulfill the rights of recognizing the Imam of this age. May He keep us forever on the paths of His pleasure.

A Prophet's Guide to Anger Management

an is weak. He struggles and grapples with natural urges of anger at times. It's a constant back and forth of irritation and self-control.

Recently, I was running late to the mosque and was stuck behind a slow car for miles. I found this irritation creeping within me and eventually I was at a crossroads. Do I maintain my composure or give in to the urge?

Researchers have noted the rise of such occurrences. A poll conducted by National Public Radio and IBM Watson found that some 84% of people surveyed said Americans are angrier today compared with a generation ago. [https://www.npr.org/sections/health-shots/2019/06/26/735757156/poll-americans-say-were-angrier-than-a-generation-ago]

Similarly, Harvard Medical School has found that nearly two-thirds of U.S. adolescents have experienced an anger attack that involved threatening violence, destroying property or engaging in violence toward others at some point in their lives. [https://hms.harvard.edu/news/uncontrollable-anger-prevalent-among-youth]

One of the prominent companions of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) and among the greatest scholars of Islam, Hazrat Maulvi Abdul Karim Sialkoti (may Allah be pleased with him) has explained that, "There is primarily one dangerous weakness that ought to be reformed and which is the root of all internal disorder. What is that weakness? It is the habit of constant criticism and to be quickly irritated. These flaws characterize a mean and narrow hearted person about whom it can easily be concluded that they live a life of hell." [*Life of the Promised Messiah*^{as} (2022), p. 23]

Is being irritated quickly not but another name for short temper? If we aspire to break free from the shackles of hell in this world, we must rid ourselves from the sway of anger.

The Holy Qur'an is clear on this topic. Addressing the believers, Allah enjoins,

وَسَارِعُوْا اللي مَغْفِرَةٍ مِّنْ دَّبِّكُمْ وَجَنَّةٍ عَرْضُهَا السَّمٰوْتُ وَالْأَرْضُ الْعِدَّتْ لِلْمُتَّقِيْنَ ﴾ الَّذِينَ يُنْفِقُوْنَ فِي السَّرَّ آءِ وَالضَّرَّ آءِ وَالْكُظِمِيْنَ الْغَيْظَ وَالْعَافِيْنَ عَنِ النَّاسِ وَاللَّهُ يُحِبُّ الْمُحْسِنِيْنَ

And vie with one another in asking for forgiveness from your Lord, and for a Paradise whose price is the heavens and the earth, prepared for the God-fearing — those who spend in prosperity and adversity, and those who suppress anger and pardon men; and Allah loves those who do good. (3:134–135)

If we desire to earn entry into Paradise or earn Allah the Almighty's love we must suppress our tempers and pardon those who may enrage us. The Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) has declared,

"The heart which leaps into fury and is enraged when faced with the opposing side is deprived of sagacity. And the mouth that recklessly utters foulness is deprived of perspicacity. Anger and wisdom do not go together. A short-tempered person is foolish and dull in perception. He does not ever triumph in any field." [*Malfuzat* (1984), vol. 5, pp. 126–127]

A life of Hell, deprivation of God's love and pleasure, bereft of wisdom and perception. These are all consequences of dealing with untamed anger.

Hazrat Maulvi Abdul Karim Sialkoti (may Allah be pleased with him) has written in his book *Life of the Promised Messiah*^{as} that through witnessing the conduct of Hazrat Ahmad (peace be upon him) and self reflection, he was able to improve his own spiritual condition. Perhaps by reading a few such accounts of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), we too may improve our spiritual states and begin the journey to break free from the shackles of immorality.

Hazrat Maulvi Abdul Karim Sialkoti (may Allah be pleased with him) narrates one brilliant story:

"It so happened that during the days when His Holinessas was writing At-Tabligh, Maulvi Nur-ud-Din Sahib came to see the Promised Messiahas. His Holiness^{as} had penned a very important two-page exposition and he felt a sense of pride on account of the eloquence and articulacy with which God Almighty had graced his writing. The text was to be given to me for translation into Persian ... His Holiness^{as} handed the papers to Maulvi Sahib so that he could read them and then give them to my humble self. On the way, Maulvi Sahib accidentally dropped these papers and upon returning to our abode, he took a seat. His Holiness^{as}, as was his custom, went into his private quarters. I mentioned to someone that today His Holiness^{as} has not sent any pages of text; the scribe is after me and I still have to translate the relevant text. As I caught sight of Maulvi Sahib, his face was turning pale. With extreme anxiety, Maulvi Sahib rushed people back on our steps and said: "Hurry, stand up, the papers have fallen somewhere along the way." Maulvi Sahib was mortified and worried beyond measure. He thought to himself, what a humiliating oversight; what will His Holiness^{as} think about me and how utterly irresponsible I am in that I could not even hold on to one piece of paper—and such an important paper at that. When His Holiness^{as} was informed about this, he came out as normal, with a cheerful face and a gentle smile, and instead sought pardon and said: 'Maulvi Sahib, you

have suffered such grief on account of the paper being lost. I regret that you underwent such struggle and toil in search of these papers. It is my belief that Allah the Exalted will bestow upon me something better." [Life of the Promised Messiahas (2022), pp. 35–36]

If you were in the midst of an assignment, not just any assignment but one that you felt was done in an especially excellent manner. How would you react upon learning that it was lost? All those hours and hours of work—gone. The Promised Messiah's^{as} example is the standard of self restraint and patience we are striving to achieve. An unwavering trust in Allah and an unshakeable core of morality.

He continues:

"On one occasion, the Promised Messiahas was suffering from a severe headache and I was also sitting with him inside. Nearby, there was excessive noise and disturbance. I submitted: 'Your Holiness, this noise does not cause you pain, does it?' The Promised Messiah^{as} said: 'Yes, it gives me relief when they quiet down.' I said: 'Why does His Holiness not instruct them then?' His Holiness said: 'You tell them in a gentle manner; I do not have the heart to say anything to them.' Even in the severest of illnesses, he will be all alone in a small room, and he will stay there so silently, that one would think he is comfortably asleep. He will not complain to anyone for not giving him attention, or for not offering him water, or for not tending to his other needs." [Life of the Promised Messiahas (2022), p. 37]

When we are battling an illness, it is very easy, in fact it is common for one to become irritable and demand that their needs are given preference. Just recall the last illness you dealt with and see if you ever faced this temptation. Going forward, it is our obligation to emulate the model of Hazrat Ahmad (peace be upon him) and suppress any tempers which flare.

In his Friday Sermon of October 10, 2014, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) pointed out that it is our duty to completely abide by our teachings. If we look at other faiths, such as Christianity, they too preach peace and love—and many live by those principles. What, then, is the difference between us if we bicker and argue? He explains that our truth will be evident when we practice what we preach to such an extent that such practices are completely gone or at the very least unrecognizable.

One scenario which commonly tempts us towards anger can be found in our very homes. Nowadays, with people

working or studying at home, we require complete silence to complete our work. If even a conversation is being held, our concentration breaks and we get distracted from the task at hand which can very easily lead to yelling and lecturing. Such predicaments arose throughout the life of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) too. In fact, it occurred as he carried out his divine mission and fought the Jihad of the pen.

Hazrat Maulvi Abdul Karim Sialkoti (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated:

"I have observed His Holiness^{as} when he is absorbed in writing the most subtle and intricate of expositionsat times even his matchless, most articulate of books in the Arabic language. Nearby a chaotic uproar may be ensuing in full surge, children or simple women may be arguing with one another disrespectfully, or yelling; other ladies may even be engaged in altercation as women do. However, His Holiness^{as} will continue writing and remains so absorbed in his work as though he was sitting alone in quiet seclusion. All of his unparalleled and magnificent books in Arabic, Urdu and Persian were written in these sorts of circumstances. On one occasion, I asked the Promised Messiahas: 'In such noise does His Holiness not feel the least disturbed in writing or thinking?' He smiled and said: 'I do not hear them, why and what sort of disturbance could this cause me?' [Life of the Promised Messiahas (2022), pp. 33–34]

One could argue that the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) would be justified in yelling at the members of his household for providing such a tumultuous background to such important work. Yet, he always exercised patience and self control. This provides us with a roadmap on how to live our lives. Perhaps we are not blessed with the focus of Hazrat Ahmad (peace be upon him), but if we require quietness it must be achieved in a kind and caring manner.

If one were to study the biography of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) we would see that he faced numerous trials: false cases aiming to slander his character, the abuse of opponents from all factions of society, ridicule and persecution from seemingly every faith. But despite that, he never let his anger come out. He completely subdued it.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) has made it clear for all of us,

"The Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), who came as the Messiah of Prophet Muhammadsa, has a scope of forgiveness and forbearance that extends to the entire world. Therefore, we too need to expand our own capacity for forgiveness and forbearance. These are the standards that we should achieve. If we wish to benefit from the light of Allah, we also need to develop patience, resilience, and forbearance within ourselves. If we want to utter words of wisdom and profound knowledge and advance the mission of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), we must avoid harshness and anger in our domestic and everyday dealings ... If we want to become true believers, we must utilize our abilities appropriately, timely, and in the right manner." [Friday Sermon dated October 10, 2014]

When I felt that agitation flaring within me while driving, I thought of the examples displayed by the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), and by God's grace vanquished that sensation. Through pondering over his outstanding guidance others can overcome such trials as well.

The Martyrdom of Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib of Afghanistan

s an Ahmadi Muslim, when one thinks of Afghanistan, two great people come to mind. Hazrat Sahibzada Abdul-Lateef Sahib Shaheed (may Allah be pleased with him) and Hazrat Abdur-Rehman Sahib Shaheed (may Allah be pleased with him). These two companions of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) were the first Ahmadis to have the honor of embracing martyrdom. There was also a third, lesser-known missionary of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama'at to be martyred in the land of Afghanistan.

Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib, son of Amanullah, was a resident of a village called Khauja which was in the subdivision of Rakha in the district of Panjshir, situated near Kabul, Afghanistan [*Al-Fazl*, September 11, 1924, p. 5].

After accepting Ahmadiyyat, he travelled to Qadian in pursuit of knowledge where he was admitted to Madrasa Ahmadiyya. In 1919, while Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib was still a student in Madrasa Ahmadiyya, Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) instructed him to return to his homeland to teach and train the Ahmadis of Afghanistan.

At that time, Ahmadis were not free to practice their faith in Afghanistan, so Maulvi Sahib would teach the Afghani Ahmadis individually. Around this time, on February 20, 1919, Habibullah Khan, King (or Amir) of Afghanistan, was killed. The next to take up the throne was Amir Amanullah Khan who, soon after becoming the Amir, announced that there would be freedom of religion for all people in his kingdom [*Al-Fazl*, October 25, 1924, p. 3].

Following this announcement, in August 1919, Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) sent Naik Muhammad Khan Sahib of Ghazni along with some other men to meet a delegation that had come from Af-



ghanistan under the leadership of Mehmood Tarzi Sahib, the Foreign Minister of Afghanistan, who had travelled to England to ratify a treaty. Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) did this to gain some insight about the current policies in Afghanistan, specifically inquiring about two main things: (i) Was there freedom of religion for Ahmadi Muslims? and (ii) Could those Afghani Ahmadi Muslims who had migrated to Qadian return to Afghanistan?

In this Afghan delegation, there was a Hindu who was serving as Afghanistan's finance minister. When he discovered that Naik Muhammad Khan sahib of Ghazni was the son of Mir Ahmad Khan (the former governor of Ghazni) who had migrated to Qadian at the age of fourteen because he did not have religious freedom in Afghanistan, he began to cry and hugged him saying that your father was my brother [*Al-Fazl*, October 25, 1924, p. 3]. He said, "Return to your homeland; I will protect you." Mehmood Tarzi Sahib also made the same promise [*Al-Fazl*, June 14, 1956, p. 3]. Tarzi Sahib further made the promise that no Ahmadi would be harmed because the time of cruelty and injustice had passed.

There were two other members of the Afghani delegation who were moved to tears by the story of Naik Muhammad Khan Sahib. They were greatly saddened that the child of a well-respected family was forced to migrate at such a young age leaving all his family, friends, and homeland behind. They said that this would no longer happen in the time of Amanullah Khan, Amir of Afghanistan.

The Ahmadi delegation returned in high spirits, considering their trip a success. However, Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) demonstrated great wisdom in remaining cautious and instructing Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib to meet with Mehmood Tarzi Sahib upon his return to Afghanistan. Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) specifically instructed Maulvi Sahib to inquire about the injustice being done upon the Ahmadis of Afghanistan and to seek permission to mention these issues to the Amir of Afghanistan himself.

There were constant reports being received of Ahmadis being persecuted in different parts of Afghanistan, so according to the instruction of Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him), the foreign minister of Afghanistan and the famous Turkish General Djemal Pasha (Chief of Staff of the Afghan Army) were made aware of the situation through letters [*Al-Fazl*, October 25, 1924, p. 3]. The foreign affairs office of Afghanistan responded to these letters stating that "under the leadership of the King of Afghanistan none of your followers have been harmed or have received any punishment from the government and if we are provided with a list of all Ahmadis who are citizens of Afghanistan then it is possible that we may be able to provide assistance to them if they have been harmed." [*Al-Fazl*, September 25, 1924, p. 3]

After this correspondence, some Ahmadis faced hardships in Khost. So, the Ahmadiyya Jama'at sent a request to the Afghani government through the Afghani Ambassador to India. On May 24, 1923, a response was received that Ahmadis can live in Afghanistan in peace and no one can cause them any harm. They would be protected like all other loyal subjects of Afghanistan. The response also hinted that the Amir of Afghanistan had been consulted in this matter and that it was according to his suggestions that this response had been written.

Now, the Ahmadiyya Jama'at was satisfied that there was in fact religious freedom in Afghanistan and Ahmadis could live there freely. However, near the end of 1923, a report was received that two Ahmadis had been jailed by the Afghani government. Just a few months later, in early July 1924, Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib was called by the government, and he was asked whether he was Ahmadi. He responded that he was Ahmadi and although he was released, soon thereafter he was jailed again.

On August 1, 1924, Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib wrote a letter to Fazal Karim Sahib of Bhera, who lived in Kabul [*Al-Fazl*, September 11, 1924, p. 4]. He described his situation in the following words:

"This humble servant who is a missionary of Islam has been imprisoned for thirty days. The doors and windows of the jail cell are closed and only open for a short amount of time. It is also forbidden to speak to anyone. When I go for ablution, a guard accompanies me. Yet, as dark as the jail cell may be, I receive just as much light and satisfaction of the heart from God the Almighty. Please send this letter to Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih and, by telegram or by letter, convey the news of my situation to my Ahmadi brothers so that they may pray that this humble servant may be successful in serving the faith. In this jail, I constantly pray, that 'O God, make this humble servant successful in serving the faith.' I do not wish to be freed from jail or to be saved from death, rather, I say, 'O God!

May every fibre of my humble self be sacrificed for Islam." [*Al-Fazl*, September 11, 1924, p. 5]

Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib was presented in court after which on August 16, 1924, it was found that Maulvi sahib was an apostate and thus deserving of capital pun-

Later on, his case was retried in court and again, the same conclusion was reached; but instead of capital punishment, the court ruled that Maulvi Naimatullah Khan sahib would be stoned in front of a large crowd. [*Al-Fazl*, September 18, 1924, p. 5]

In accordance with this decision, on August 31, 1924, the police paraded Maulvi sahib around the streets of Kabul and announced that this person would be stoned today for the crime of apostasy, and everyone should be present to witness and participate in it. Those who saw Maulvi Sahib at this time witnessed that when it was being announced that he would be stoned to death, he did not panic or show any sign of fear, rather, his only reaction was to smile. He smiled as if it was not the news of his impending demise that was being announced but a declaration of his honour.

At last, at Asr time, people gathered in the ground of the Sherpur Cantonment in Kabul to perform the stoning [*Al-Fazl*, September 13, 1924, p. 1]. In that moment, as his martyrdom approached, Maulvi Sahib made his final request; that he should be given one last opportunity to worship his Lord in this world. Upon receiving permission from the authorities, he offered his prayers, and upon completing them, he stood up and said, "I am now ready. Do as you will."

He was buried in the ground up to his waist, and "the most respected scholar of Kabul" threw the first stone after which

stones rained down on him from all four sides until he was buried in a pile of stones and was martyred in the way of God. *To Allah we belong, and to Him shall we all return!*

At the time of his martyrdom, he showed unmatched loyalty and conviction in his faith— a fact attested to by a

newspaper based in Kabul, in its September 6, 1924 issue. It mentioned that Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib stayed loyal to his beliefs until his last breath and even while being stoned, he kept loudly proclaiming his beliefs.

On September 4, 1924, Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him) issued a statement to the Jama'at stating:

"O brothers, in this time of sorrow, we cannot forget the duty which has been imposed upon us by our blessed brother, who sacrificed his life for the cause of God. He has started the work which we must go on to complete. Let us resolve in this moment that we will not rest until we conquer the land of these martyrs (meaning until we spread Ahmadiyyat there). The souls of Hazrat Sahibzada Abdul-Latif Shaheed (may Allah be pleased with him), Hazrat Abdur-Rahman Shaheed (may Allah be pleased with him) and Naimatullah Khan Sahib Shaheed are reminding us of our duties from heaven and I have full belief that the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama'at will not forget them." [*Al-Fazl*, September 11, 1924]

Today, a hundred years after Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib's martyrdom, his unshakeable faith provides inspiration to members of theAhmadiyya Muslim Jama'at, many of whom continue to face such persecution on account of their faith. In the face of an unjust ruler and state, Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib displayed great humility and steadfastness, holding fast to the rope of Allah despite his impending martyrdom.

Today, Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib's courageous memory continues to shine on, just as it is written in the Holy Qur'an:

ٷۘۘۘڒڐڂۺڹؾۜ الَّذِين قُتِلُوٛ افِيْ سَبِيْلِ اللهِ ٱحْوَاتًا بَلْ ٱحْيَاءً عِنْدَ رَبِّهِمْ يُرْذَقُوْنَ ۞

Think not of those, who have been slain in the cause of Allah, as dead. Nay, they are living, in the presence of their Lord, and are granted gifts from Him. (3:170)

In 1924, Hazrat Mirza Bashir-ud-Deen Mahmood

Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih II & Musleh-e-Mau'ud (may Allah be pleased with him), attended the Conference on the Living Religions of the Empire in London.

A Call for Religious Freedom


While there, he learned of the brutal stoning of Maulvi Naimatullah Khan Sahib in Kabul, ordered by the Amir for professing faith in the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him). In response, he launched a campaign to raise awareness of this atrocity and advocate for freedom of faith on a global scale.

Hazrat Musleh-e-Mau'ud's^{ra} efforts included press releases, meetings, and a large protest at Essex Hall in London. He mobilized local dignitaries and media to spread the message, emphasizing the injustice of religious persecution.

Dr. Walter Walsh, a prominent advocate of religious freedom, chaired the protest meeting, which was attended by influential figures like Sir Arthur Conan Doyle and Sir Francis Younghusband. A resolution condemning the incident was sent to both the British government and the League of Nations.

This campaign marked a significant moment in advocating for religious freedom, underscoring the Ahmadiyya Jama'at's longstanding commitment to this cause.

Chief Dr. Robert Joseph, O.B.C., O.C., Gwawaenuk First Nation (British Columbia)

Chief Dr. Robert Joseph is a Hereditary Chief of the

Gwawaenuk First Nation. A residential school survivor and co-author of *Down from the Shimmering Sky: Masks of the Northwest Coast*, Chief Joseph is deeply respected for his contributions to reconciliation. He has received several honours, including an Honourary Doctorate of Law Degree from UBC and the Jack P. Blaney Award for Dialogue. In 2012, he was presented The Diamond Jubilee Medal by the Right Honourable David Johnston, Governor General of Canada. He has attended multiple Jama'at events and holds the Jama'at in high regard.

Karen Joseph, M.S.M., Musgamagw Dzawada'enuxw (British Columbia)

Karen, the eldest daughter of Chief Robert Joseph and

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Matriarch Ms. Donna Joseph, is recognized for her commitment to reconciliation and Indigenous rights. She received the Top BC Women of Influence Award in 2017 and the Meritorious Service Medal. She attended Jalsa Salana Western Canada in 2019. Due to health reasons, Karen was unable to attend and was represented by her sister, Shelley Joseph.

Roy Erasmus, R.P.C.C., L.L.B., M.B.A. (Yellowknife)

A former member of the Northwest Territories legislature, Roy has a strong connection with the Jama'at and has attended Jalsa Western Canada in 2017. His family is widely respected in the Dene community, and he has helped facilitate connections between the Jama'at and other Indigenous leaders.

Jean Erasmus, R.P.C. (Yellowknife)

Jean, originally from Fort Chipewyan, is a Dene and Cree professional counselor specializing in therapeutic services for Residential School Survivors. She spent 6 years in Indian Residential Schools and is a third-generation survivor. Jean has a deep connection to her Indigenous roots and a commitment to healing and support within her community.

Fourth Vice Chief Craig McCallum, F.S.I.N. (Saskatchewan)

Vice Chief McCallum, the Chief for 74 nations in Saskatchewan, is also a former national hockey player, advocates for Indigenous youth and frequently collaborates with the Jama'at to promote unity and understanding. He organized a First Nation event at Baitur Rahmat Mosque in Saskatoon and always appreciates Jama'at efforts to bring people together.

Chief Donny Ironchild, Little Pine First Nations (Saskatchewan)

Chief Ironchild is very well-respected Chief within the First Nations Communities across Canada. He is a good friend of the Jama'at and supports the Jama'at's humanitarian initiatives. He is active in promoting cooperation between the Jama'at and Indigenous communities.

Tristen Amyotte, Youth Leader (Saskatoon)

Tristen is instrumental in organizing youth events between the Jama'at and Indigenous communities, including a basketball tournament that saw over 200 participants this year. He is a respected figure among First Nation youth.

Leonard Sapp, Thunderchild First Nations (Lloydminster)

High school diploma (Grade 12) with minimum average of 80% marks in academic subjects.

2. Age:

Date of birth must be later than August 31, 2005.

3. Medical Report:

Medical Report from a practicing physician certifying good health of the applicant.

4. Written Test & Interview:

The applicant must pass a written test. The study material for the test is the Waqf Nau Syllabus up to 15 years of age. Only those candidates who would score higher than other candidates in the Written Test and Interview and fulfill the other criteria as well would be considered for admission.

5. Application Procedure:
